

Nebraska Rural Water Association recently completed our latest water and sewer rates study of all systems across the State. The last study was completed in 2008. It is interesting to look through the study and see what water rates have done over the past 3 yrs. Overall, Water rate minimum charges have increased an average of 8.5%. The average charge per 1,000 gals. Has increase 7%. The smallest of systems, (under 400 pop.) fall right in line with the average. Systems 400-2,000 population had an average increase of approximately 4%. While systems 2,000 and larger had the largest average increase of just under 13%. The larger system rates are still considerably less than the smaller systems simply due to economy of scale. NeRWA would like to thank all systems who participated in the survey.
